Good afternoon, employee-owners:

Below is an update on our COVID-19 response. The first part is additional information and the second part provides answers to the questions that have been submitted.

QUESTIONS SUBMITTED:

1. The CARES Act allows for up to \$100,000 distributions from 401k's due to COVID-19. Currently, Garney's Plan with Vanguard does not allow for this type of distribution. Is this something we can look into changing?

ANSWER: The CARES Act permits Coronavirus Related Distributions (CRDs) to individuals affected by COVID-19. **Effective next Wednesday, June 10, Garney is implementing this provision in our 401(k) plan**. Below, are the details of the allowable distributions:

An "affected individual" is defined as someone:

- 1. Who is diagnosed with COVID-19 by a CDC-approved test.
- 2. Whose spouse or dependent is diagnosed with COVID-19 by a CDC-approved test, or
- 3. Who experiences adverse financial consequences as a result of being quarantined; being furloughed, laid off, or having work hours reduced as a result of COVID-19; being unable to work due to lack of child care due to COVID-19; closing or reducing hours of a business owned or operated by the individual due to COVID-19.

The CRD provision permits the following:

- 1. Distributions up to \$100,000 from qualified plans and IRAs by affected individuals.
- 2. Distributions made on or after January 1, 2020 and before December 31, 2020 qualify.
- 3. There is no mandatory 20% federal tax withholding requirement and the 10% early withdrawal penalty is waived.
- 4. The taxes associated with the income attributable to CRDs can be paid pro-rata over a three-year period.
- 5. A participant taking a CRD may repay the amount of the distribution within three years.
